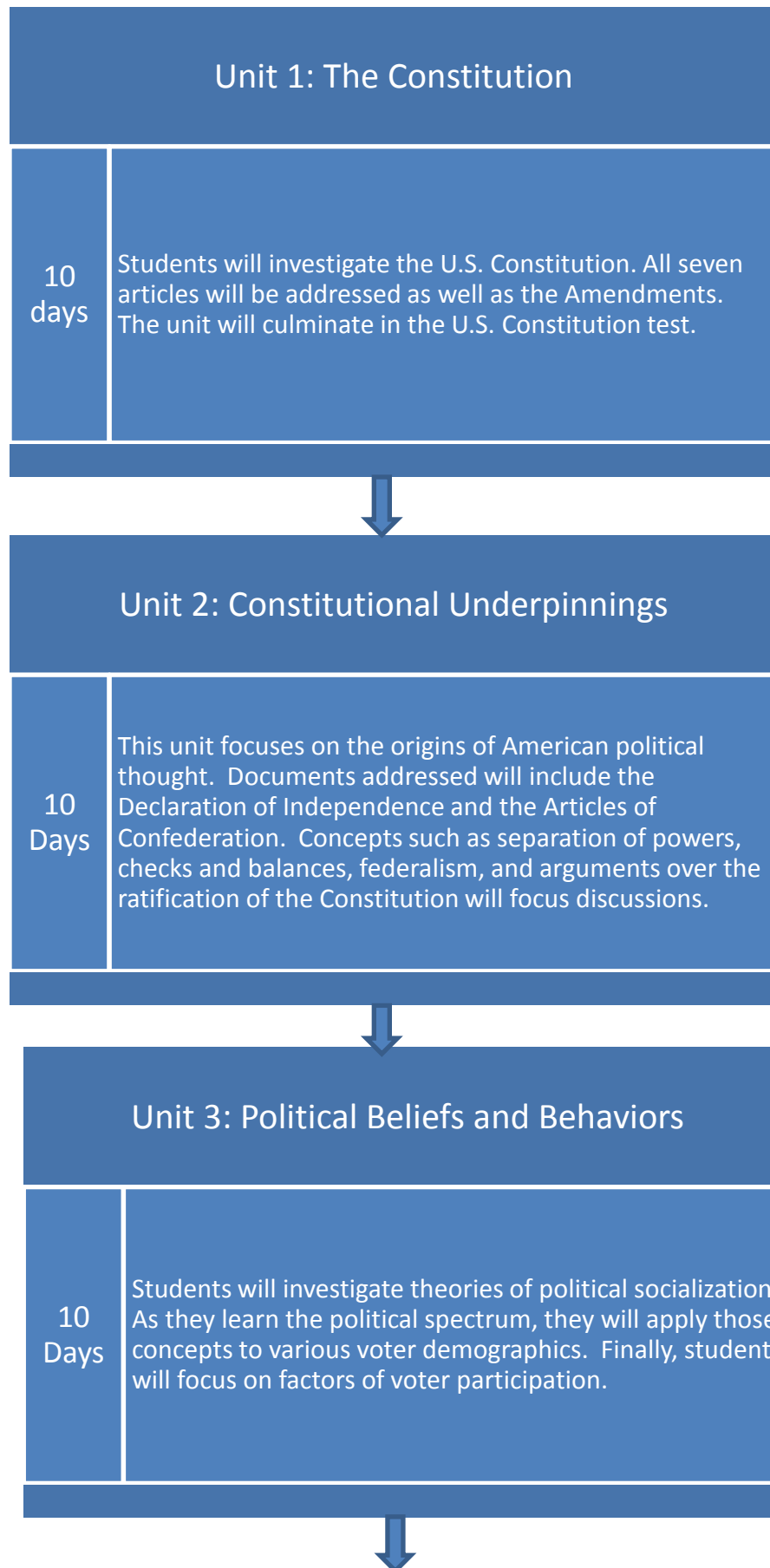

## Unit 4: Linkage Institutions

Days

This unit focuses on the institutions that serve as a link between the people and the government: interest groups, political parties, media, and elections. Each student will become an expert on one of the Power 25 interest groups.
