



### Unit 1: English Grammar Part I

60  
days

Students will learn present , present progressive, future, and past tenses and use them in sentences, questions, short answers, and negative sentences. Students will define, recognize, and use pronouns, adjectives and adverbs, learn the spellings of singular , plural , possessive, regular and irregular nouns. Students will learn and use comparisons in sentences and reinforce grammar skills through the side by side grammar computer program.



### Unit 2: Writing

45  
days

Students will learn the writing process, paragraph form, and structure. Students will learn the parts of a paragraph and their role, learn how to write a title for a paragraph, recognize signal words, and learn paragraph unity and time order. Students will write descriptive, narrative, and opinion paragraphs and letters.



### Unit 3: Reading

days

Students will be able to read the first 100 sight words from the Doch list. Students will read a variety of short stories to cover and reinforce basic literary terms: narrator, 1<sup>st</sup> person vs 3<sup>rd</sup> person, plot, conflict, problem, resolution, and character.



## Unit 4: Spelling

Students will spell the first 100 sight words from the Doch list.
