Reavis High School is proud to offer the Illinois State Seal of Bilingualism and Commendation Toward Bilingualism for students who demonstrate proficiency in one or more languages in addition to English.



- The Seal of Bilingualism is awarded to students who demonstrate intermediate high proficiency in the non-English language and proficiency in English.



- The Commendation Toward Bilingualism is awarded to students who demonstrate intermediate low proficiency in the non-English language and proficiency in English.

Interested student will need to do the following:

- Submit an application to the Curriculum Department, Room 149 including a fee of \$20.
- Demonstrate proficiency in English through one of the following methods:
 - AP English Language Score of 4 or 5
 - SAT Exam EBRW Score of 480 (Class of 2018) and 540 (Class of 2019+)
 - ACT Exam Composite Score of 21
 - EL students may earn an ACCESS composite score of 4.8
- Take the STAMP S4 exam in one or more of the following languages: Arabic, Polish, or Spanish. The following scores are needed for each award.
 - **Seal of Bilingualism:** Intermediate High
 - **Commendation Toward Bilingualism:** Intermediate Low
- If a student meets the requirements for one of these awards, he or she will receive a seal or commendation on their diploma during the summer following graduation. The student's transcript will also be marked to show the Seal or Commendation.
