Unit 1: Culture & Diversity

17
Days

This unit covers the three main sociological perspectives as well as the meaning of culture and diversity. Students will examine what it means to be a member of a society and how cultural differences play a role in society.



Unit 2: Conformity, Adaptation, & Social Structure

22
Days

This unit explains how cultures maintain order and bring about change. Additionally, the building blocks of social structure will be investigated. Students will summarize the American Value System, analyze how social control is kept, and describe how human interaction is affected by social structures.



Unit 3: Adolescence & Socialization

Days

This unit identifies how individuals socialize and examines adolescent development. Students will explain how personalities are developed, their impact on socialization, and they will identify the major challenges adolescents face today.



Unit 4: Social Institutions

Days

This unit covers major social institutions, including the criminal justice system, the education system, and religion. Students will explain the concepts of deviance and crime, the sociological view of education, and the sociological view of religion.
