

PA 99-590 was signed into law on July 22, 2016. The legislation requires each school district in the State to report to ISBE information concerning the administration of assessments to students at each school building. The following chart describes the standardized assessments that will be administered at Reavis Township District 220 during the 2017-2018 school year, including the assessment's name, entity that mandates the assessment, the student population tested under that assessment, and the primary use of that assessment within the building.
