Prom 2022 - Registration Check-List

In order to register for Prom you must submit the following **at ticket sales**. Tickets will be available **March 31st and April 1st during the lunch periods right outside the cafeteria**. Prepay online **before** picking up your tickets at the Prom Registration table.

- Completed **Registration Form** which is included in this packet of materials.
- Tickets are \$180.00 per couple and \$90.00 per single ticket. Use e-Funds portal for online payment - <https://payments.efundsforschools.com/v3/districts/56331/>
- **GUEST PERMIT** for any guest who is NOT a REAVIS STUDENT. Student guest permit must have your **DEAN'S APPROVAL** and **SIGNATURE**. Guest permits are included in this packet of materials. **PHOTO COPY** of your guest's photo ID (ONLY if they are NOT a Reavis Student)
- Proof of your meeting with your Dean for any guest age 21 and older.
- **Table request form**. If not submitted at the time of ticket pick up, must be turned in by Tuesday, April 19th to room 260 (Ms. Wielgos).

Prom Etiquette

Attire:

This is a formal event. Prom participants are required to be dressed in formal attire.

Reception:

As you enter the reception area, a table will be set up for you to check-in and receive your Prom favors and table number. When you purchase your Prom ticket, you will be given an invitation and a receipt. Save your receipt to present when you check-in. You do not need to bring your invitation to the Prom. **Bring your school ID. Check-in will begin at 6:30 pm.**

Conduct:

This is a night to showcase Reavis students at their best. Many hours have been spent in planning an evening that will delight you and generate pride in your school. It is expected that you will act in a mature, responsible manner. Be advised that inappropriate conduct will result in disciplinary action according to the rules set out in the Student handbook. **Parents will be notified if necessary. No refunds will be given.**

School Attendance: In order to attend the Prom, school attendance (**periods 1-7**) is mandatory on Friday, April 29th.

Photographic Packages

Photographic packages will be offered by Lifetouch.

Photographers will be available at the Hyatt from **6:30pm to 10:00pm**. Choose a package before Prom night and bring the order form and payment with you on the night of Prom.

Photography order forms will be available to you when you purchase your Prom tickets outside the cafeteria. Be advised that only appropriate poses are permissible and the photographers retain the right to refuse taking a photograph of an inappropriate pose.
