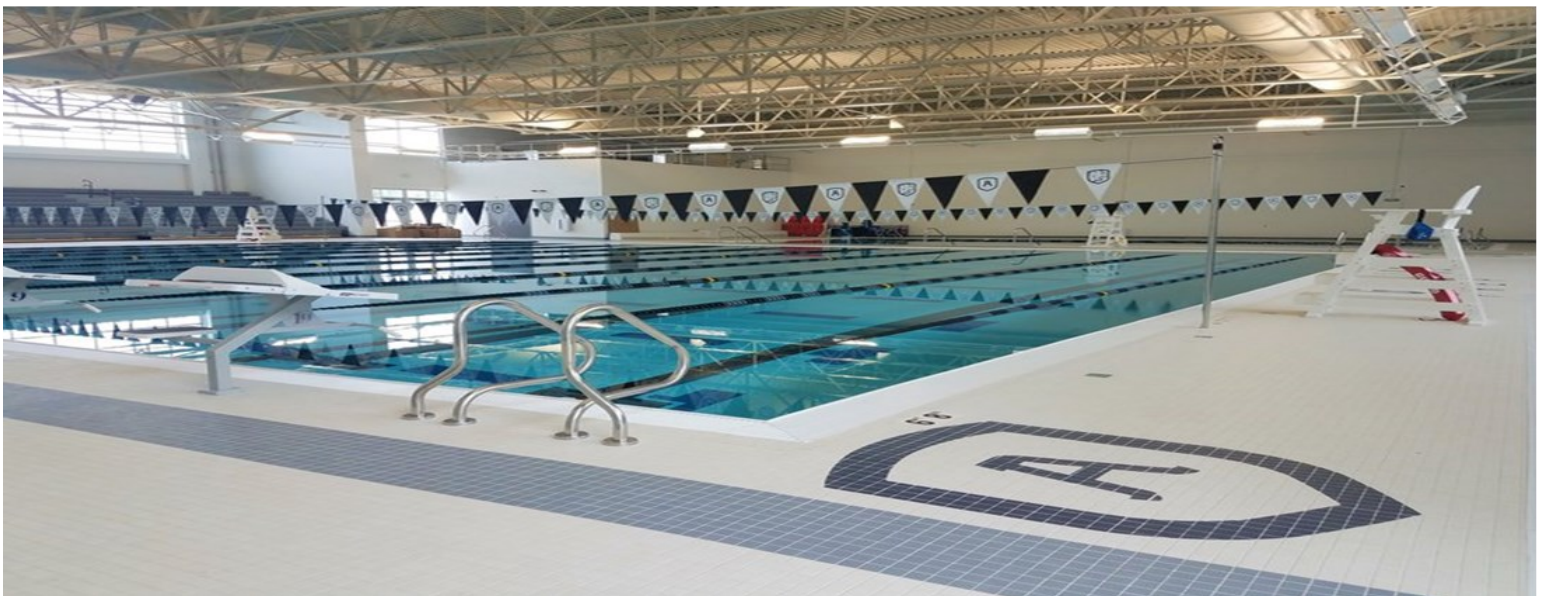

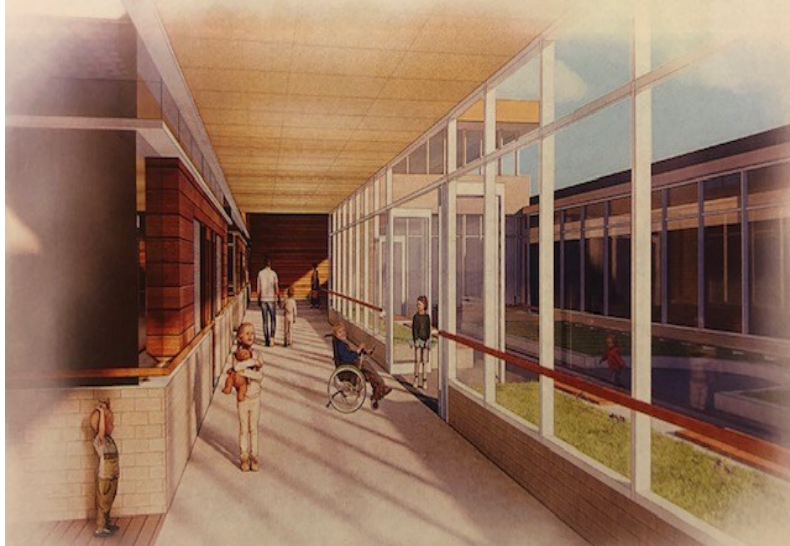

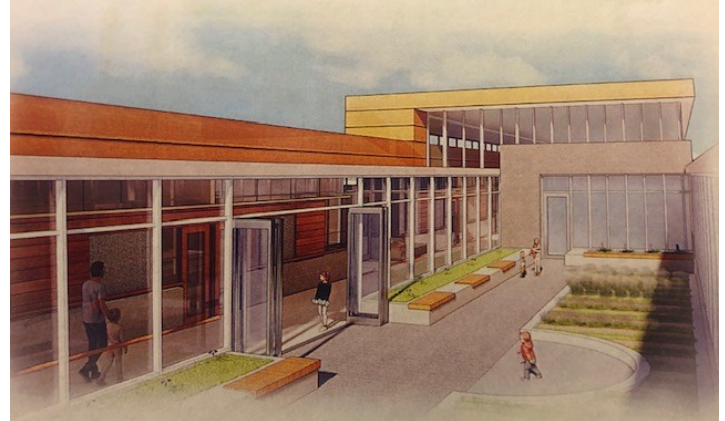

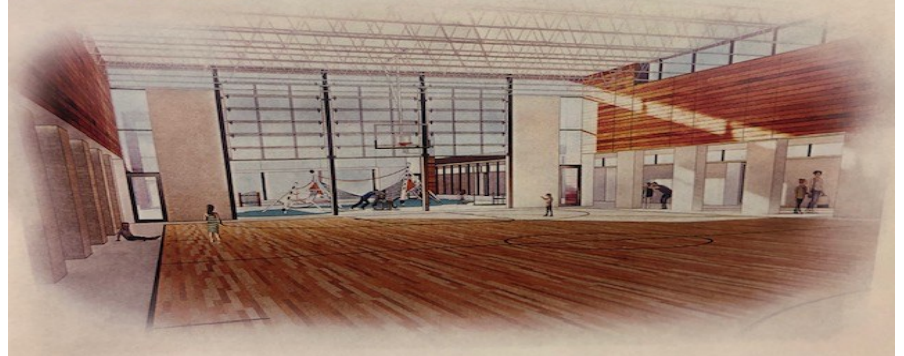

Capital Development & Building Bond Question:

*“Shall the **Board of Education of Reavis High School District Number 220**, Stickney Township and Cook County, Illinois, **construct, improve, renovate, alter, repair, and replace portions of the Reavis High School Building and Campus**, including, but not limited to, building a new **Field House**; improving **School Safety, Communication, and Emergency Response Systems and Equipment**; renovating the current **Industrial Tech/STEM/Pool Wing**; altering facilities to make them **Americans with Disabilities Act** accessible to persons with disabilities; repairing a 70-year old building infrastructure; improving the **HVAC, electrical capacity, plumbing, roofing, tuck pointing**; and to assist in funding the District’s portion of a new **A.E.R.O Special Education Cooperative Building**, and issue bonds of said School District to the amount of \$45,000,000 for the purpose of paying the costs thereof?”*

1. Why the need for these capital improvements?

- Reavis High School is the flagship and foundational institution of the Burbank & Stickney Communities.
- We attract families to the district because we offer a student-centered environment, rigorous academic programs, and top-notch facilities to foster a first-rate educational experience.
- The passing of this bond issuance, and the projects that will ensue, would signify the importance the community continues to place on education and solidifies the district as a driving force in economic development and community stability, not only for today's students, but for all future generations.

2. What will the money be used for?

- **Life Safety Projects:**
 - Update our Security Communication & Emergency Response System.
 - Renovation to our North Wing HVAC, Plumbing, Electric, Roofing, & Tuckpointing.
 - ADA upgrades to Washrooms, Locker Rooms, and Hallways.
- **Tech/S.T.E.M. & Pool Wing Renovations:**
 - Renovation to our Tech/S.T.E.M. Wing & Classrooms, including the Auto & Wood Shops.
 - Renovation & Replacement of all tiles to our Pool and Pool Deck, plus a new Filtration System.
- **New A.E.R.O. School Building:**
 - Allocation of Reavis's portion for a newly constructed A.E.R.O. Building on the former Queen of Peace property.
- **Fieldhouse Addition:**
 - Approximately 80,000 - 100,000 Sq. Ft. Facility.
 - 6 Lane – 200M Track & 4 Basketball/Volleyball/Badminton Courts.
 - New Fitness/Weight Room, Dance Room, and Medical Training Room.

3. How will this affect my property tax bill?

- It is not permanent, but it will stay consistent for the length of the 20-year loan.
- A \$100,000 property value would be \$5 a month/\$63 a year (homeowner exemption applied).
- A ***Tax Calculator*** has been added to the Reavis website, so community members can input the home value listed on their property tax bill to determine the exact yearly and monthly cost.

4. Will Burbank & Stickney Community Members be able to use these new facilities?

- Yes...ALL Burbank & Stickney citizens, groups, teams, and organizations will be allowed to use these facilities, during approved dates and times, free of charge.
